Making a gift in your will

When considering a gift in your will to the Malaghan Institute, you have several options for support. We recommend consulting a solicitor who will give specialised advice on which option would work best for you and your family. If you have already made a will, it is very easy to update to include additional gifts. Depending on how you decide to support our medical research, we suggest the following wording:

LEAVING A SPECIFIC GIFT OR AMOUNT

"I give to the Malaghan Institute of Medical Research the residue of my estate to be used for _____ (eg a specific area of research or general purposes) and I declare that the receipt of the Director or other proper officer shall be a full and sufficient discharge to my trustees."
